Kearney Mansion Museum and Park Is located at:

7160 E. Kearney Blvd. / Fresno, CA 93706

The Park is located just South of Whitesbridge Road, South/West of the West end of Hwy. 180, and is between the city of Kerman and Fresno, not far from Highways 99, 180 and 41 intersections.

You may arrive anytime after 8:30 a.m. Please park your trucks and trailers directly behind the Kearney Mansion in our staging area. There is plenty of room on the hard dirt surface. **There will be a drivers meeting at 9:00 a.m. in the staging area**, where you will receive your packets and your start time. Drivers and anyone riding with you must sign the "CVHA Hold Harmless agreement". Please be ready to drive 15 minutes before your start time at the rear entrance (behind the mansion) for a safety inspection followed by a turnout inspection at the beginning of your drive. You will then drive the designated route followed by a fun and easy cones course. You will then take care of your horses and secure them at or in your trailer. If you are participating in the traditional picnic, you will have 30 minutes after the last turnout finishes their drive to be ready with your picnic to be judged. Please bring your carriage with food and anything else you need to the designated picnic area and set up your picnic. Anyone not taking part in the traditional picnic competition may bring their lunches to the picnic tables to eat lunch under the shade trees. Beverages will be provided. After the picnic judging is completed, awards will be announced. It *may* be possible for you to drive at will through the park afterwards (stay tuned by checking the website or an announcement will be given the day of the event). Slow moving vehicle signs will *not* be required or even suggested as they detract from the overall impression of this traditional drive. If you leave the park to drive on open roads, then you will need to have a SMV but they are not required inside the park.

Please remember to be safe & courteous! Please clean up after yourselves and your horses. We need to leave the park by 4:00 p.m. Entries will be limited due to time constraints.

We hope you enjoy this traditional carriage-driving event and have a good old fashion time with family, friends and of course, the horses!
