Directions: From Hwy 99 either North or South. Take Hwy 180 West. Hwy 180 turns into West Whites Bridge Road. Turn Left (South) on South Grantland Ave. Proceed to back parking area by Turning Left (East) on Kearney Blvd and Right (South) on Fair Ave. Turn Right (West) on Cypress and follow to Kearney Mansion.

- **All Drivers, grooms, and passengers will need to check in before driving in the Park and sign the “Hold Harmless Release. Check in will take place in front of Kearney Mansion**
- **Safety Check at sign in**
- **Course Distance is between 3 and 5 Kilometers over paved paths. Cones course on grass**
- **All Turnouts should be properly attired for a Pleasure Drive (Hat, gloves, apron, and whip-in-hand required)**
- **All Turnouts will need their slow traffic triangle as the Park is open to automobile traffic. Horses must be traffic safe. No green horses please.**
- **Tables provided for lunch with drinks provided**
- **Tours of Historic Kearney Mansion during the day**
- **Awards given at lunch. Drive at will through the Park after lunch. Awards to be announced.**
