Volunteer Valerie Tyrrell Receives Therapeutic Driving Certification



Valerie Tyrrell, a volunteer at Happy Trails Riding Academy, recently received her certification as a Driving Instructor for children and adults with disabilities. "I have never done anything that daunting," explained Valerie, as she described the process of achieving her certification as a PATH, International Certified Driving Instructor. Valerie recently attended a three-day workshop followed by two days of testing in Lexington, Kentucky. Of the eight participants in the Driving Certification course, Valerie was one of only two who passed.

Driving allows a student with a physical, mental or psychosocial disabilities to interact with a horse or pony while driving from a carriage – either two-wheel or four-wheel. Therapeutic Driving gives a student who may not be able to ride on a horse the ability to interact and connect with their equine partner by holding the reins and guiding the horse and carriage.

Valerie looks forward to the challenge of assisting her students to develop the correct touch on the reins, so that they have that special connection with the horse. "When you get the right contact, not too much and not too light, it is almost like a dance," explained Valerie. "It is such an esteem builder and it's a lot of fun," she added. Participating in driving will also give the student an awareness of where the horse is, where the cart is, and where the wheels are going. "Some of our students may never be able to drive a car, but they will be able to drive a cart," explained Lisa-Cotta Meek, program director at Happy Trails.

The staff and board of directors are extremely proud of Valerie for her accomplishment in achieving her Therapeutic Driving Certification and we are grateful for the hundreds of hours she had put in to prepare for her certification. "We are thankful that we have such wonderful and dedicated volunteers, like Valerie, so that we can expand the therapeutic programs that we offer at Happy Trails. We expect to begin offering therapeutic driving instruction in 2012."

What's Happening?

CVHA RamTap Horse Driving Trial & Playday

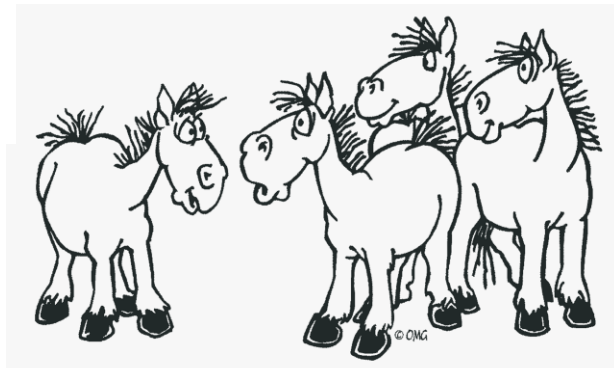
Lois Patten has handed over the organizing reins of the RamTap HDT/Playday to Phyllis Rumley. The non ADS sanctioned HDT will be held on March 24 & 25, 2012 at the RamTap facility in Fresno, rain or shine.

The way the event will work is the drivers will drive one day and volunteer the other day, volunteering is mandatory for all competitors. Only Training and Preliminary Levels will be offered. If entry space allows, trainers and upper level drivers will go HC, judged but not placed in the classes. The Judges will be Jody & Gregg Cutler, who have held this type of drive/volunteer event at their Oak Run Farm in Moorpark for many years. It is a good way for newer drivers to have the opportunity to drive an outside course at a real CDE facility, and also to learn by watching other drivers do it as well. There will be a safety check for all drivers and helmets must be worn by all persons on the carriages at all times. Medical armbands and safety vests are recommended for participants as well. Drivers who are not competing will be allowed to drive in certain areas not being used for the HDT while drivers are competing, then allowed to drive the courses and hazards afterwards.

Entries for this event will be limited, so get your entry in as soon as possible. Forms for the event are included in this newsletter, as is a membership form.

WKRP Horse Show Carriage Driving Classes

Phyllis Rumley is also organizing the Driving Classes at the WKRP Horse Show held at Verde View Farm in Sanger, where she boards her horses. The Driving classes will be held on Saturday, starting at 10:00 AM, and the rest of the Horse Show will be held on Sunday. This way, the drivers will have more parking and more driving area for warm-up and courses. This is a great place to drive and train and have some low key competition and FUN! There will be three Driving Classes offered: A Timed Cones class, an Obedience Cones class and an Obstacle class. All classes will be on a small outside course with numbered pairs of cones with balls on the tops of the cones. The Obstacle course will have cones as well as a few portable obstacles to be driven. The same classes will be offered for folks who are not ready to hitch or want to warm up their greener horses in the Ground Driving classes. Show dates have been added to the calendar of events and are subject to change and /or cancellation due to weather or lack of entries or volunteers.
