

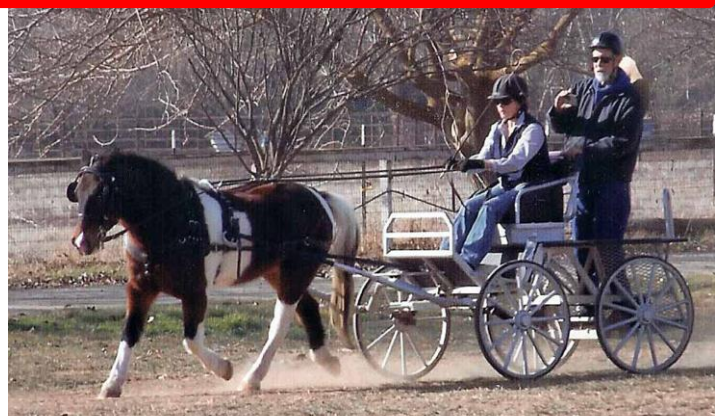

Treasurer's Report:

Phyllis then discussed the HDT and said club members will receive a \$10.00 discount on stabling and \$5.00 off the grounds fee. The \$50.00 grounds fee will be waived for those competing that wish to practice the prior day.

Gretchen moved to adjourn, second by Dee and approved by all at 8:00 P.M.

What's Happening?

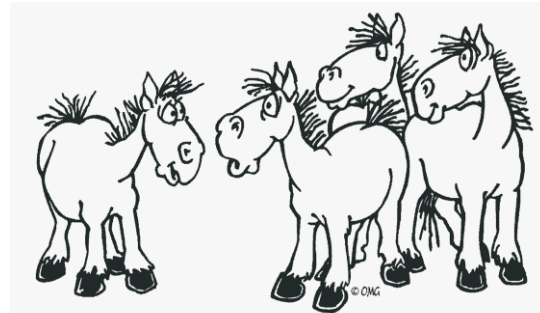
The February W&KRP Carriage Driving Classes at Verde View Farm in Sanger were scheduled for Saturday, February 11, but were canceled due to rain. The March W&KRP show will be on Saturday, March 3, 2012 and will be a Driven Dressage show. The tests will be the same as the ones at the RamTap HDT later that month. Training level will drive the ADS Training Level Test #4 and Preliminary will drive ADS Preliminary Test #1. The tests can be found on the American Driving Society website at <http://www.americandrivingsociety.com/>

Ronda McPherson will be the dressage judge for the March W&KRP show and folks can enter and drive the tests twice at \$9 each, post entry will be \$10 to encourage pre-entering. There will also be a timed cones course class at \$9, or \$10 post entry. For all competitors there will be a \$5 California drug fee and a \$5 grounds fee. There may be a hazard to practice driving also. Time permitting, competitors may drive their test a third time for free. This is a good opportunity to be judged before competing at the RamTap HDT in a casual atmosphere with friends to help you prepare.

Entries for the RamTap Horse Driving Trial on March 24-25, 2012 are still open. Competitors will drive one day and volunteer the other day, this is mandatory for all competitors. Helmets must be worn by all persons on a carriage at all times. There will be a safety check before Dressage. Come drive at one of the most popular CDE facilities on the West Coast! Big open spaces and water hazards to splash through, what could be more fun? Centrally located in Fresno, right in your own backyard, don't miss it, enter today! Entries close March 10th.

The May and June W&KRP Driving Classes will be Cones Scurry Classes, details in upcoming newsletters.

Note that there is a new date in October for the Fall Classic Pleasure Driving Show at Claystation Horse Park and now there will be a Sporting Day of Traditional Driving at Shady Oaks that month also.

Directions to Show: South/North toward Fresno on Hwy 99 take Herndon exit (east) toward Fresno across RR tracks at light. Immediately (50 yards) turn north on Weber Ave, continue 25 mph thru village ½ mile to grounds.
